### 2011 Contingency Requirements

- \$500 cash or \$1,000 product award per event weekend
- If only supporting Karts a minimum of \$100 cash or \$300 product per event weekend

### Contingency awards

- Must be paid in full 1 week after finalized results are sent, unless the specified award is an end of the year championship award given to the top winner in the series in their class.
- Must be specific to which class will receive the award and to what place it rewards (i.e. only 1<sup>st</sup> place, top 3 racers, or top 3 racers running your specific parts, etc.)
- Awards must be given (to least one class) at every 2011 event
- May create specific rewards (i.e. hole shot, half way incentives)
- Must provide proof of payment to drivers. If any drivers receive your award you must fax, email, mail evidence of payout to the specific driver to contingency directors no later than one week after results have been sent.

### Administration Fee

- All companies wishing to participate in the Lucas Oil Off Road Racing Series Contingency program will be required to pay a \$250 administration fee to be accompanied by the contingency agreement one week or more prior to the first event of the season.

### Contingency Row/Booth space

- All contingency companies wanting to display at the events will be put only in contingency row that will be located behind the grand stands.
- Contingency displays must look professional, no beat up, tattered EZ ups. It is up to the discretion of the contingency directors to determine if the display is up to standard and allowed at the event.
- Each Contingency Company will be allotted a 10x10 space to accommodate your display. If more space is needed, please contact contingency one week in advance to notify of the change of space needed. Additional charges will be applied for areas greater than 10x10.
- All Contingency companies may sell out of their display. (Must have proper seller's permit certification). There is no limitation on what may be sold out of the display as long as it is legal and appropriate. No alcoholic beverages or tobacco products may be sampled or sold. All products must be approved by contingency directors.
- All contingency companies will receive service passes to get into the pits and a parking pass. Loading and unloading passes will only be issued from Wed. thru Fri. This will only be given to a vehicle that will be moving display item in and out of the pit and will need to be removed before the start of the event weekend..
- All contingency contracts must be received one week prior to event in order to reserve space for your company. If all necessary information is not received in time, you will not be permitted to participate in the event. NO EXCEPTIONS.
- **AT ALL EVENTS DISPLAYS ARE NOT TO BE BROKEN DOWN UNTIL 30 MINUTES AFTER THE LAST EVENT ON SUNDAY. IF SET UP IS BROKEN DOWN BEFORE SPECIFIED TIME A \$200 FINE WILL BE CHARGED. EACH ADDITIONAL TIME THIS OCCURS ANOTHER \$100 FINE WILL BE ADDED ON TOP OF THE \$200 FINE.**



**NO COMPANY WILL BE ALLOWED TO SET UP IF THEY DO NOT PAY THE FINE BEFORE THE NEXT EVENT.

### 2011 CONTINGENCY SPACE AND PRICES

Option 1: Given when contingency contracts are received

10x10 space, 4 general admission, 1 temp parking pass, and banners can be displayed only within display booth.

Option 2: \$300

10x20 space, 4 general admission, 1 temp parking pass, and banners can be displayed only within display booth.

Option 3: \$600

20x20 space, 4 general admission, 1 temp parking pass, and banners can be displayed only within display booth.

Option 4: \$900

20x30 space, 4 general admission, 1 temp parking pass, and banners can be displayed only within display booth.

Option 5: \$1,200

20x40 space, 4 general admission, 2 temp parking passes, and banners can be displayed only within display booth.

Option 6: \$1,500

20x50 space, 4 general admission, 2 temp parking passes, and banners can be displayed only within display booth.

## **TERMS AND CONDITIONS FOR ALL VENDORS**



- 1) Vendors shall submit the required booth fee with application.
- 2) Load-in time: two days prior to first event date.
- 3) Due to increased security measures, never leave your vehicle unattended at any time while within the venue. Do not leave backpacks, packages, boxes, bags, unattended outside your booth at any time.
- 4) Vendors are required to be open on Saturday and Sunday from opening to end of event. Closing before end of event or staying open after end of event is grounds for exclusion from participation at future events.
- 5) Consumption of alcoholic beverages by vendors at their booth is prohibited.
- 6) Vendors must provide trash receptacles for waste generated by their booth. Improper trash disposal is grounds for exclusion from participation at future events. Trash will be picked up after the event each night, if properly bagged and left in front of the booth.
- 7) Electrical requirements: All electrical appliances must conform to the uniform fire code of the specified county.
- 8) Permits: You are required to obtain and display all necessary permits and/or licenses in order to operate on the festival grounds.
